Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labeling

#	Pictogram	Symbol	Hazard Types
1	Flame		Flammable gases, liquids, solids, aerosols; self-reactive; pyrophoric; self-heating; organic peroxides
2	Flame Over Circle		Oxidizers - may cause or intensify fire
3	Exploding Bomb		Explosives, self-reactive, organic peroxides
4	Corrosion		Skin corrosion/burns, eye damage, corrosive to metals
5	Gas Cylinder		Gases under pressure - compressed, liquefied, dissolved
6	Skull & Crossbones		Acute toxicity (fatal or toxic) via oral, dermal or inhalation
7	Health Hazard		Carcinogen, mutagen, reproductive toxicity, respiratory sensitizer, organ toxicity, aspiration hazard
8	Exclamation Mark		Irritant, skin sensitizer, narcotic effects, respiratory tract irritation, acute toxicity (harmful)
9	Environment		Aquatic toxicity - hazardous to the aquatic environment

DANGER - More severe hazards

WARNING - Less severe hazards
